



What Should I Have in My Horse's First Aid Kit?



First Aid Basics Kit

- ✓ Thermometer
- ✓ Standing wraps or polo wraps
- ✓ Eye wash
- ✓ Hoof pick
- ✓ Halter/lead rope
- ✓ Flashlight/headlamp with batteries
- ✓ Pelleted complete feed such as Equine Senior or grass pellets
- ✓ Stethoscope (practice listening to horse's gut sounds at different times of day)
- ✓ Watch with second hand

Foot Abscess Kit

- ✓ Epsom salts
- ✓ Animalintex pad or Magnapaste
- ✓ Diaper (infant to size 2, depending on size of horse)
- ✓ Vet wrap
- ✓ Duct tape

Laceration Kit

- ✓ Permanent marker
- ✓ Gloves
- ✓ Nolvasan/Betadine solution
- ✓ Gauze squares
- ✓ Superglue
- ✓ Triple antibiotic ointment
- ✓ Non-adhesive pads (Telfa is a typical brand found at feed stores)
- ✓ Cotton sheet/combine leg wrap
- ✓ Gauze roll
- ✓ Vet wrap
- ✓ Bandage scissors
